The City Council of the City of Center Point, Alabama met in Regular Session at the Center Point City Hall on Thursday, January 21, 2021, at 6:30 p.m.

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Council President D.M. Collins.

Councilwoman Jones seconded the motion. President Collins called for a roll call vote: Councilwoman Copeland-yes, Councilwoman Jones-yes, Councilwoman Moore-yes, Councilwoman Copeland-yes, Councilman Williams-yes, President Collins- yes. President Collins declared the motion passed unanimously.

Education & Library- Councilwoman Sharon Jones, Chair- Encouraged the residents to join the PTA to support our kids.


Finance Report: Councilwoman Ebonee Copeland, Chair- No report


Adjournment:
